FOR FAMILY PHYSICIANS

To start the process you need to contact The College of Family Physician of Canada. Web site: www.cfpc.ca

It is the legal certifying body for the practice of family medicine in Canada. The licensing body for physicians & surgeons in Ontario is The College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario. Web site: www.cpso.on.ca

After the 2 colleges reviewed your qualifications, they will inform you whether you need to go through further training & examination, or whether you can qualify for an alternative pathway in which you can work under the supervision of a family physician for one year, go through a chart assessment process & then qualify to work as a family physician in Ontario.

FOR SPECIALISTS (MEDICAL OR SURGICAL)

It is the governing body of specialists in Canada .It will direct you to contact the corresponding specialist society.

After the 2 colleges reviewed your qualifications, they will inform you whether you need to go through further training & examination, or whether you can qualify for an alternative pathway in which you can work under the supervision of a specialist for one year, go through a chart assessment process & then qualify to work as a specialist in Ontario.
